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## Itinerary

Derbyshire had probably been our guests' most requested 'new' Byway destination over the years and in 2009 finally became a reality! We are delighted to return to our remarkable accommodation at Dannah Farm for a second year. Less formal than a hotel but so much more than a B&B. Dannah Farm is a genuine taste of luxury with all rooms highly individual and featuring items and styles from the past mixed with contemporary finishes in furnishings and fabrics to create a stunning place to spend our week. Food at Dannah Farm is the very best in farmhouse cooking and we will enjoy three full dinners and one buffet supper here, eating out at some fine and interesting places, discovered last year, on the other nights and possibly taking our main meal at lunch time on one day. Derbyshire itself offers us many and varied delights. It is a county rich in grand houses and gardens - large and small, in fascinating churches and superb scenery. So for 2010 we hope to visit: Chatsworth - perhaps the stateliest of all Stately Homes, the magnificent abode of the Duke and Duchess of Devonshire is a jewel in England's crown; the fortified medieval manor house of Haddon

Hall; Hardwick Hall one of Britain's greatest and most complete Elizabethan houses. We will visit some lovely private gardens too

and would hope to choose for you the very best in each tour season. Scenic highlights abound and its many small lanes make Derbyshire ideal 'Byway' territory. Carsington Water lies near Dannah Farm; the road across Axe Edge Moor into the Goyt Valley offers us lovely views down the length of Errwood Reservoir; Monsal Head is one of the most photographed viewpoints in the Peak District; Dove Dale maybe the most well known of all; Winnats Pass is a spectacular limestone gorge, near Castleton and its four show caves, that will lead us to Mam Tor, the Hope Valley and Edale ; the unique beauty of the Manifold River Valley; and moor meets dale as the

road swings down the famous Snake Pass under Kinder Scout and on towards the Upper Derwent Valley and the Ladybower and Howden Reservoirs. Lesser known spots such as Alport Heights, Parsley Hay, Crich Hill and Ogston Reservoir will also be included. Tidewell's St. John the Baptist meanwhile is the most complete medieval church in the region and Youlgrave's is another to be acknowledged to be amongst the county's finest. The beautiful Estate village of Tissington, places of huge historic industrial significance such as Wirksworth, the Cromford Canal and Caudwell's Mill along with the most famous stone circle in Derbyshire at Arbor Low are all likely destinations too. We would also hope to visit a well dressing (the calendar is issued early in the new year) and as on all Byway holidays we will also show you beautiful lanes, vistas and visits that most people miss entirely!
