For 2010, we celebrate our sixth year in this beautiful and dramatic part of the British Isles with its ancient peaks, valleys, castles and spectacular coasts and rivers, by offering a **brand new itinerary!** Choose from Spring or Autumn - both particularly beautiful times in Snowdonia. The tour itinerary is of course still to be finalized but may well include: The Roman Camp at Trawsfynydd; the Forest of Coed Y Brenin and the Kings Guard Trail to the giant Douglas Firs or the Forest Garden 'trees of the world'; Barmouth with its waterfront memorials and historic buildings and the remote mountain road to Cwm Nantcol and to the historic Baptist Capel Salem made famous by the painter Sidney Vosper. A day including a visit to the grave of Lloyd George designed by

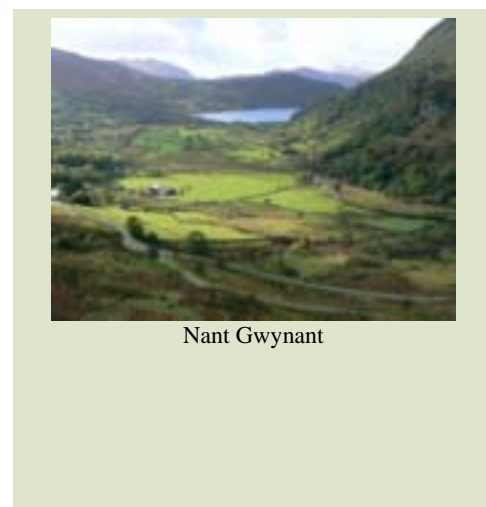


Sir Clough Williams-Ellis, and to Criccieth with its waterfront castle on the fringes of the Llyn Peninsula will also see us take more empty mountain lanes to

Cwmystradllyn and the Cwm Pennant slate industry remains set amidst wonderful and spectacular scenery; perhaps a wander on the unique 'Y Lon Goed' ('the wooded road'), a fascinating tree lined avenue immortalized by the poem of R. Williams Parry, and to Afon Wen Beach before taking the back road to Borth-y-Gest and Porthmadog. Anglesey will not be forgotten either on our Snowdonia wanderings as after Rhyd Ddu, Waunfaar and Caernarfon, we include a visit to Plas Newydd Country House and Gardens famous for its Rex Whistler mural. It also features splendid views



to the mountains and a marine walk.
